So me and photographer **Jo** thought helping out with our club, Dandenong MCC at the 2016 **Yamaha** ATV MX Nationals last weekend would be the best way to keep me distracted. That was, until I saw they were holding a Vets Over 40 Solo class. Darn it. There were the cream of the Gippsland MX Series out on that superbly prepped track having a ball in between the four wheel races. No pressure, racing each other for pit lane bragging rights. Just my sort of thing. There will always be next year though.



So we rolled into the club grounds at Wonthaggi around 8am Saturday morning and **Glenn Capuano** quickly got me a hi-viz vest and out I went to the track to flag. The place looked fantastic and the four wheelers ripped around the track in a pace that looked as quick – or quicker than the usual motocrossers. In fact the fastest Pro Open time was 9 seconds faster than the fastest time recorded at the recent club motocross champs. It was just the jumps and whoops that slowed them a little. In fact in the SXS class it slowed **Simon Evans** #199 so much he left the track with a three wheeler after tumbling forwards off the big table top four times. No injuries to Simon but the car was unfixable.

KYABRAM'S AIDAN ROBINSON DEFENDS NATIONAL TITLE AT WONTHAGGI

KYABRAM'S Aidan Robinson is again a national champion, winning the 250cc Junior title at the 2016 Australian ATV MX Nationals in Wonthaggi last weekend.

Aidan, 15, won the extremely-contested junior class by just 4 points over Jae Dowsett and 15 points over Jakob Bosustow.

Aidan won one out of his five races, finishing second in every other race to successfully defend the title that he won at last year's ATV MX Nationals in Alice Springs in August 2015.

After admitting he didn't have the best preparation in the lead-up to the national event, Aidan was surprised that he managed to win it again.

"I wasn't really planning on it but it's always good to come home with the win. The bike went a treat after we rebuilt it before the event," Aidan said.

"In the first race, I got a pretty good start and came out in third-place. A few of the riders in front of me made a few mistakes and I managed to get up in front and win the first race so that was good," Aidan, who won his first race by 02.646 seconds, recalled.

"In Race 2, I got another good start and finished second and on Sunday, I got three straight seconds and managed to get the overall," Aidan, who also had to compete with blustery conditions at the Wonthaggi track yesterday, added.

"The wind was really windy on Sunday, it was a challenge," Aidan added. "There was some really close racing between some of the riders, especially the boys from Western Australia," he added.

Aidan will still take part in the Quad Rider Club of Victoria's Club Off-Road Series with the last round to take place at the State Motorcycle Sports Complex at Broadford on October 22 and the final round of the QRCV ATV MX Club Rounds at Warrnambool in November.

"I'd really like to thank 3B Small Engines, Hardiman ATV, Fox Shocks, Lonestar Racing, Scott Motorsports, Pigatto Constructions, my brother for putting in all the time and effort into my bike, and to everyone else, including my family, who has helped out throughout the season," Aidan added.

19 year old **Chris Bosnakis** from Perth WA has won 13 state champs, 9 national titles and now 3 Aussie Pro Champs, and also raced in USA this year.

The top three Pro Open riders have all dominated the Nationals since 2011. **Ryan Fritz**, Communications Manager MV interviewed one of them, Victorian **Mitch Van Vliet** before the event

“Riders are coming from New Zealand and all over Australia. It’ll be one of the biggest Pro Open races the discipline has ever since quads became really popular,”

Mitch, 25, who has also recently competed at the Finke Desert Race and is the 2014 China International ATV Invitational champion, loves the family-friendly nature of the sport: “It’s not as intensely competitive as the two-wheeled disciplines.

It’s a really family-friendly sport,” Mitch, who races against his both his younger brothers Jake Van Vliet and Cooper Van Vliet, added.

Mitch is a big fan of the track at Wonthaggi too. “I’ve competed at Wonthaggi heaps of times before. I’ve had a number of coaching schools there and it’s a wicked track. It’s really wide, there’s lots of passing opportunities.

“With quads, one line usually forms but it doesn’t seem to at Wonthaggi so that’s why it was chosen,” Mitch added.

Asked what advice he’d give newcomers to the sport, Mitch added: “Give it a try. It’s a fun sport and it’s got a great atmosphere.”

“I’d really like to thank our major sponsor *Yamaha Australia* for supporting this event too, plus my Mum, Trudy Van Vliet, and all our other supporters, including *Legend Quads*, *Hardiman*

ATV, Vanika Industries, Quad Squad, Victory Meats, Austraco, Spy and Thor, who have got behind us.”

With the dust increasing, the racing finished with the Open class Back to Back spot on 4pm and it was time for a well earned steak and beer in the local town.

My task for the day was to keep up the food and drink to all the flaggies driving around on the club’s quad. It was tempting to join in the racing but I restrained myself. 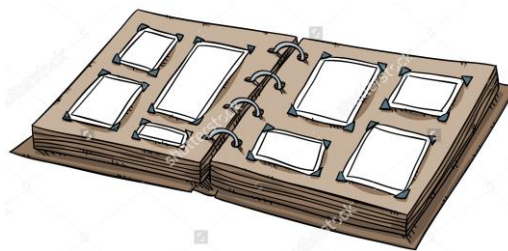

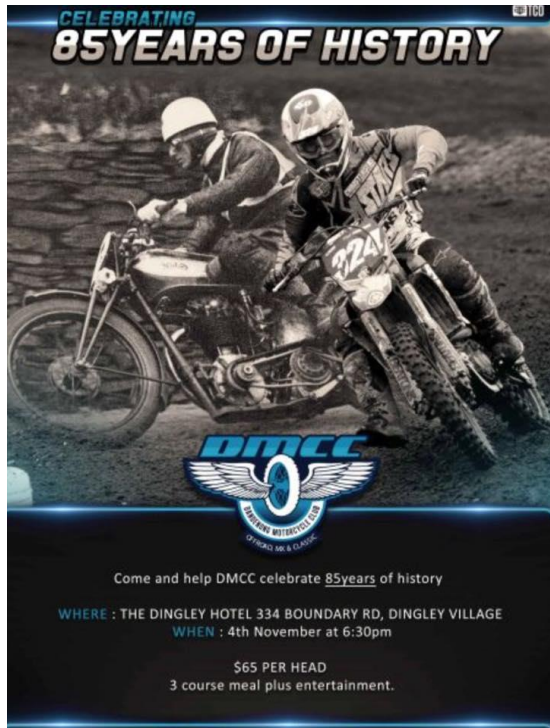

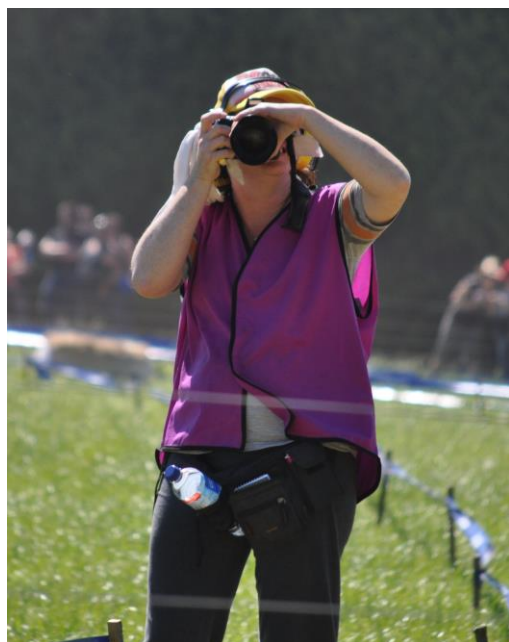
