The track had taken a fair bit of punishment from the ATV MX Nationals the weekend prior and some areas were still a bit hard and skatey, and a strong north-westerly wind added to the conditions to challenge the riders. But everyone applied some common sense and the day was generally smooth sailing. And in a treat for spectators there were some regional, state and national champions providing fast and close racing – here's some of the excitement via photos:

SCOOTER NEWS has been a long-term supporter of **Aaron Bonfadini** #X who is back preparing for a big year in 2017 after some injury hiccups. He has taken ownership of a CRF450 and came along today with his training buddy **Cam Bayliss** in Cam's first ever race. And we have had our eye on young Yamaha motocrosser/supercrosser **Angus Gelly** #330 for a few years too and he is just wrapping up his first year in seniors with Victorian titles in B Lites and B

Open. Today they were both in A Open and Aaron was soon getting his race craft sorted. Race one saw him battling into third position just behind fast starter **Tom Carroll** #31, with **Angus Gelly** a long way ahead. Race two Aaron was second into the holeshot corner behind **Tom Carroll** and quickly passed him to lead for a brief moment before he lost the front end and stalled. Coming from dead last Aaron climbed back to about sixth by the chequered flag, which was taken once again by **Angus Gelly**.

It all had to come together in the last race. Aaron was fourth into the first corner and picked his way quickly through the front runners to reel in **Angus Gelly**, gradually narrowing the gap before Angus binned it and Aaron was able to squeeze past. Angus was lightning fast back on the pace to chase Aaron down, managing to pass him again half way around the last lap, only a second would have split them at the finish line. And to put it into perspective Angus was on a 250. So it was 3 from 3 for the young hurricane Angus who was quick to shake hands with Aaron at the end of the race, he's a great kid and looks set for a very successful 2017.

First up the **Yamaha Blu Cru** Women's World Trophy Team of **Jessica Gardiner, Tayla Jones** and **Jemma Wilson** achieved a fourth (yup 4) back to back title – an incredible result especially considering both Tayla and Jessica had been sidelined with injuries this year.

Chucky spoke to MA: "It has been one hell of a ride. We've had all conditions, from dry and dusty terrain to wet and slippery. We have had some fun out there along the way on the 300 and to come away second overall, and winning the E3 class, I am pretty stoked with it," Sanders shared.

"It would have been cool to win the outright but everything doesn't always go to plan over six days, even though you wish it would. We have learnt a bit this year and are ready for next year, where will have another crack at it.

"It has just been an awesome time with the whole of team Australia and the supporters. We couldn't do it without all the guys who support us all.

"It feels good to finish second. Unfortunately, mistakes cost it for me, but that happens. Winning the E3 class again was awesome, I had a good lead in the end. Today on day six I just didn't get a good jump off the gate and it buried me mid pack. I just carried through and tried to make as many passes as possible.

"We only rode for eight minutes and it was the most intense eight minutes you could ride on a bike. It's good training for the four day, so we will be ready for that," Sanders concluded. (MA Media)

TRANSMOTO 6 HOUR CONONDALE QLD 15 - 16TH OCTOBER

Report by Shaun Baker

"The Transmoto 6-Hour is a unique, team-based dirt bike event that's somewhere between a recreational trailbike rally and an enduro race. It's a shorter, punchier, less challenging version of the notorious Transmoto 12-Hour, which has been running since 2011, but still caters to riders of all levels. And, in keeping with the 12-Hour's **successful recipe**, the 6-Hour focuses on fun-factor rather than officialdom. The inaugural Conondale Transmoto 6-Hour was held at the legendary Green Park circuit in Queensland, featuring sections of the world-famous motocross track, creek crossings, lush rainforest, hill climbs, grasstrack and flowing bush tracks crafted by the Sunshine Coast MCC crew."

Our mate **Shaun Baker** and his riding partner **Glenn Mustard** headed over to give it go and met one of the legends of our sport just back from Morocco:

2016 SUPERCROSS SERIES UPDATE ROUND 2, TOOWOOMBA



Round 2 of the Australian Supercross championships took place last Friday 14th October at Toowoomba Showgrounds in QLD. Two American riders dominated the SX1 podium, Monster Energy Kawasaki's **Wil Hahn** and the winner Honda Genuine Racing's **Justin Brayton**. **Mitch Evans** #43 in SX2 has withdrawn from the rest of the championship with an injury. The US style track was over 700 metres long and contained close to 10,000 tons of dirt.






